YEAR 3 REQUIREMENTS - 2017

Dear Parents,

At the beginning of 2017 it will be necessary for children to have each of the following items listed below. (Items do not all need to be brand new but should be in good condition.) We have decided to forward this list prior to the end of the year, so that there will be a smooth beginning to the 2017 school year.

Please note that all 'regular shaped' exercise books will be covered in the school crested book covers. These will be provided at the start of the year. They must be labelled with name, class and subject.

It would be appreciated if the following items were labelled and available for the first day of term:

- 3 x Display book with clear front cover
- 4 x whiteboard markers, in a zip-lock bag
- 2 x plastic wallet folder
- A4 Blank Art Sketch book
- 30cm ruler marked in cm and mm
- 6 x HB pencils
- 2 x erasers
- 2 x highlighter (any colour)
- Pencil sharpener with cover (not battery operated)
- 4 x Glue sticks (not liquid)
- Scissors
- Set of coloured pencils (no gel pens)
- Lightweight headphones (not earphones), clearly labelled in a zip-lock bag pencil case
- Book for daily reading - from home or the library
- Raincoat (rain hat for girls)

Music Requirements

- Music Box file (to fit recorder and square book)
- Pencil with eraser
- Descant Recorder - Available from Mrs Barr
- Recorder mop and Joint Cream - Available from Mrs Barr

These will be distributed at the beginning of the year and will be charged to your term account. Please label BOTH recorder and case when you receive them.
